Pest Management

PEST MANAGEMENT (595) – Control infestations of State and Local Noxious Weeds or invasive plants to reduce their adverse effects on the natural resources and their potential for spread. The most effective method of control is through the development of an annual pest management plan. This plan will include scouting and documenting locations and then selecting control methods: i.e. chemical, mechanical, and/or biological control.
