

Access Control

Maintain the stand of permanent vegetative cover according to program guidelines for the life of the CRP agreement. No collection of seed or crop production is allowed on these fields. CRP acreage shall not be hayed or grazed during the contract period, unless permitted by the USDA Secretary of Agriculture during disaster declarations or as allowed by managed haying and grazing provisions. All management or maintenance activities shall be conducted outside of the primary nesting and brood rearing season for ground nesting wildlife. The primary nesting season in South Dakota is May 1 to August 1. Consult with NRCS and FSA officials before any management activities are planned and carried out.

Pest Management

PEST MANAGEMENT (595) – Control infestations of State and Local Noxious Weeds or invasive plants to reduce their adverse effects on the natural resources and their potential for spread. The most effective method of control is through the development of an annual pest management plan. This plan will include scouting and documenting locations and then selecting control methods: i.e. chemical, mechanical, and/or biological control. All pesticides will be applied in accordance with label requirements. Fields labeled with an "R" (potential for pesticide loss to surface waters due to runoff) or an "L" (potential for pesticide loss to shallow aquifers due to leaching) have areas within the field that have potential for pesticide loss by runoff or leaching. Consult the local USDA NRCS office for the location of specific areas within these fields. Pesticides with an Intermediate, High, or Very High Pesticide Loss Potential and Hazard Rating* (See Pesticide Screening Spreadsheet) can be used IF an appropriate set of control measures are implemented. Refer to the Conservation Plan Map or Water Quality Risk Assessment Map for locations of potential pesticide loss and water quality impairment.

*A Pesticide Hazard Rating refers to adverse effects on human and aquatic vertebrates only and do not address other effects that pesticides use may have in environmentally sensitive areas i.e. riparian zones.

Pest Management

Weeds and other pests will be controlled. Noxious weeds must be controlled for the life of the CRP agreement. Manage agricultural pest infestations (including weeds, insects, and diseases) to reduce adverse effects on plant growth and minimize environmental impacts. Evaluate alternatives and select an appropriate method of control after identifying the pest infestation. Alternative pest management methods include cultural, biological and chemical controls. Spot treatment may be allowed during the primary nesting season if prior approval is obtained from the FSA county committee. The primary nesting season in South Dakota is May 1 to August 1. All chemicals must be used in accordance with the label recommendations and federal and state laws. (In the contract support document)

The cattle trails and eroded areas will be vegetated following SD NRCS standard for Critical Area Planting (342) using native species.
